

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON
BY-LAW NO. 27 - 2022

Being a By-Law to prohibit the unauthorized disposal of waste, regulate a recycling system and regulate the disposal of waste at the Wollaston Waste Site/Transfer Station within Municipal jurisdiction.

WHEREAS Section 11(2) of the **Municipal Act**, 2001, as amended, gives municipalities the authority to pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction as described in the Table to this Section;

AND WHEREAS the Table in this Section lists waste management as a “sphere of jurisdiction” for lower tier municipalities;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the Township of Wollaston deems it necessary to establish rules and regulations governing policies relating to the disposal of waste, mandatory recycling and to implement tipping fees (see Schedule “C”).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:

SECTION 1 – DEFINITIONS

1. “Biomedical waste” shall mean whether solid or liquid, including but not limited to, any animal or human organ or part thereof, bone, muscle, or animal or human tissue or part thereof, used bandages, poultices, dressings, vials, syringes or any other similar material or substance which contains or may contain pathogenic micro-organisms or which may be hazardous or dangerous as designated and Regulated in REG 347 and the Environmental Approval Certificate for the site;
2. “Bag Tag” shall mean a clearly identifiable sticker approved for sale by the Township of Wollaston and used to indicate that a fee has been paid;
3. “Bag Tag Fee” shall mean a fee paid for the purchase of a bag tag as outlined in Schedule “C” to this By-law or any amendments thereto;
4. “By-law” shall mean this By-law, including any Schedules forming part of it, together with any amendments to this By-law or its Schedules;
5. “Garbage Bag” shall mean a clear, plastic bag manufactured for the purpose of collecting household garbage for disposal provided that the filled bag does not exceed 18 kg (40 pounds) in weight, is fastened at the top by a bag tag and having a maximum size of 79 cm x 109 cm (31” x 43”);
6. “Council” shall mean the Council of the Township of Wollaston;
7. “Domestic Waste” shall mean the waste produced by the property owner in their homes;
8. “Household Hazardous Waste” shall mean waste requiring special care as itemized in Schedule “A” to this By-law;

9. "IC&I" shall mean waste produced by the Industrial Commercial and Institutional Sector;
10. "Property Owner" shall mean the legal title holder of the property, the occupier of the property, or the person for the time being, managing and receiving rent of the land or premises or occupier of the property who, under the terms of the lease, is required to repair and maintain the property in accordance with municipal by-law;
11. "Premises" shall mean and include one self-contained dwelling unit, residential or commercial;
12. "Recyclable" shall mean those classifications of waste capable of being diverted from the normal waste stream as specified in Schedule "B" to this By-law;
13. "Refuse" shall mean the same as "garbage" or "waste";
14. "Salvaging" shall mean the licensed removal of material for the purpose of reuse;
15. "Scavenging" shall mean the process of finding items for the purpose of reuse;
16. "Special Area" shall mean an area at the Waste Site/Transfer Station, designated for a particular purpose;
17. "Township" shall mean the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston;
18. "User" shall mean an individual or corporate entity entitled to place refuse into the Township of Wollaston's Waste Site/Transfer Station;
19. "Waste" shall include domestic, commercial and solid non-hazardous, non-recyclable refuse and other wastes as designated by the Township, as approved by the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (or the current Ministry at the time);
20. "Recyclable Material" shall mean discarded materials and goods incidental to the operation of households, business establishments and public places that can be reused or recycled;
21. "Waste Site/Transfer Station" shall mean the lands located at 70 Rose Island Road, being Part of Lot 17, Concession 9, in the Township of Wollaston, in the County of Hastings with a Provisional Certificate of Approval and any amendments issued by the Ministry of Environment, its predecessor and/or assigns;
22. "Waste Site Attendant" and "Waste Site Manager" shall mean the person duly appointed and responsible for supervision and control of operations at the Waste Site/Transfer Station and are referred to in this By-law as the Operating Authority;
23. "Unacceptable Waste" shall mean waste not accepted at the Waste Site/Transfer Station as itemized in Schedule "A" to this By-law;

SECTION 2 “MANDATORY CLEAR WASTE BAGS” AND “TIPPING FEES”

- 1) All waste must be brought to the landfill Waste Site/Transfer Station in clear bags;
- 2) Tipping fees for materials other than Domestic Waste, shall be as prescribed in Schedule “C” to this By-law;

SECTION 3 – SITE OPERATION

- 1) The Township of Wollaston operates its landfill sites (hours of operation attached as Schedule “D” to this By-law)
- 2) The Waste Site/Transfer Station shall be available for the depositing of waste produced within the Township in accordance with this by-law;
- 3) No person shall enter and/or leave the Waste Site/Transfer Station without:
 - a) Giving their name and address to the Operating Authority upon request; and
 - b) Declaring the nature and origin of the waste if requested; and
 - c) Showing a valid Wollaston Waste Disposal Site pass upon request;

The Operating Authority may request Council to suspend, terminate or restrict the privilege of using the Waste Site/Transfer Station if it is reasonably believed that a Waste Disposal pass is being used by an unauthorized person or the Rules and Regulations are being violated and the person refuses to correct the violation when requested to do so.

The waste disposal site pass may only be used by the person to whom it was issued or an employee, tenant, spouse or member of the household of such person acting with the knowledge or consent of such person. If the Operating Authority forms the opinion that the holder of a Wollaston Waste Disposal Site pass has

- Allowed unauthorized persons to use their Waste Site/Transfer Station pass
- Seriously and deliberately violated the Rules and Regulations
- Established a pattern of violating the Rules and Regulations
- Permitted someone using their Waste Site/Transfer Station pass to do any of the above

then the Operating Authority may request Council to restrict or terminate the privilege of such person to use the Waste Site/Transfer Station and revoke their site pass. Every decision of the Operating Authority to terminate or restrict the right of someone to whom a Waste Site/Transfer Station pass was previously issued shall be set down in writing by Council and delivered to the person at the address shown on the Assessment Roll.

- 4) The waste disposal site shall only be used when a Township Attendant (Operating Authority) is on duty; persons entering into the waste disposal site at any other time will be considered by the Township of Wollaston as trespassing and will be prosecuted. The attendants will be on duty and the site open as outlined in Schedule "D" to this by-law; all persons using the Waste Disposal Site shall not, under any circumstances, deposit garbage of any description in front of, in behind or near the gates leading into the waste disposal site. Waste must be deposited in its designated place.
- 5) All waste material shall be transported to the Waste Site/Transfer Station in a manner so as to prevent scattering or losing of waste while en route to the Waste Site/Transfer Station; persons intentionally dumping domestic and/or IC & I waste at the roadside will be prosecuted.
- 6) All waste must be brought to the Waste Site/Transfer Station in clear plastic bags and all persons are required to separate recyclable material from non-recyclable waste prior to disposing of same at the Waste Site/Transfer Station; no person shall bring recyclable materials or prohibited materials to the Waste Site/Transfer Station concealed or packaged in such a way as to make them appear to be items, substances or materials which are not recyclable materials or prohibited substances and materials;
- 7) Users shall separate, sort and place each type of waste in particular areas of the Waste Site/Transfer Station at the discretion of and as directed by attendants; metal items, white goods, tires, furniture, etc. will be evaluated at the discretion of the Waste Site Manager or attendant and a tipping fee paid for at the Waste Site/Transfer Station;
- 8) "Household Hazard Waste" as identified in Schedule "A" to this by-law shall not be accepted at the Waste Site/Transfer Station. This waste must be disposed of at a licenced facility designated for that purpose.
- 9) Other unacceptable items, in Schedule "A" to this by-law will not be accepted at the Waste Site/Transfer Station;
- 10) All on-site health, sanitary and site operations shall be maintained in accordance with the current Ministry of Environment Certificates of Approval;
- 11) Regulations of the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (or the current Ministry at the time), Environmental Protection Act and Certificates of Approval shall be observed at all times;
- 12) The Township reserves the right to prohibit any person, firm or Corporation from using the Township of Wollaston Waste Site/Transfer Station or to place a surcharge on high volume users;
- 13) Should a Property Owner be charged an incorrect tipping fee, the Operating Authority will notify Staff at the Municipal Office of the error and Staff will contact the individual named on the receipt to ensure the error is corrected within one (1) month of being notified of the error.

SECTION 4 – Enforcement, Repeal and Enactment

- 1) At the discretion of the Waste Site Manager, the process to deal with the contravention of this By-law shall be as follows:
 - a. verbal warning from the Operating Authority;
 - b. second warning in writing issued by the Township of Wollaston By-law Enforcement Officer or the Clerk at the request of the Operating Authority;
 - c. Waste Site Manager requests Council to formally revoke contravener's Waste Site/Transfer Station pass and levy a fine or recover costs on a municipal tax bill as described below.

- 2) That any person, firm or corporation who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law may be charged under the Provincial Offences Act and is liable to a fine not exceeding the sum of \$2,000.00, excluding costs for each offence. Where any person fails to comply with the requirements of this By-law, such matter or thing may be done at such person's expense by the Township, and the Township may recover the expense incurred in doing it by action, or the same, with interest, may be recovered in like manner as municipal taxes.

- 3) That all Schedules attached hereto form part of this By-law.

- 4) That this By-law repeals any by-law or part thereof inconsistent with the terms outlined herein.

- 5) That this By-law shall into force and effect at the date of passing.

- 6) That Schedule "A", "B", "C" and "D" attached hereto may be amended from time to time by resolution of Council without an amendment to this By-law.

SCHEDULE “A”
TO BY-LAW DRAFT - 2022

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

The following are considered to be Household Hazardous Waste and will NOT be accepted at the Wollaston Waste Site/Transfer Station. They must be disposed of at a licenced facility designed for that purpose”

1. Batteries (all types)
2. Bleach
3. Drain Cleaner
4. Gasoline mixtures
5. Household cleaners
6. Medication
7. Oil
8. Paint
9. Paint Solvents, turpentine, etc.
10. Pesticides and herbicides
11. Propane and gas cylinders (other than those used for cooking)
12. Used needles, lancets and syringes (must be placed in a sealed plastic bottle, clearly labeled as containing needles – add some bleach to bottle)
13. Aerosol Cans

OTHER UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

1. Asphalt
2. Biomedical wastes
3. Earth – rock
4. Explosives or combustible material (other than Household Hazardous Waste)
5. Hay or straw
6. Hazardous and Toxic Waste (other than Household Hazardous Waste)
7. Human excrement
8. Motor vehicles
9. PCB related material
10. Radioactive Waste
11. Raw or processed sewage
12. Unknown Waste
13. Waste from other landfill sites, former dumps and waste disposal areas except by special agreement and negotiated costs
14. Fibreglass/wood boats, paddle boards, canoes, paddle boats, boats
15. Wood & wood products (examples of wood products: brush, paneling, painted wood, wood siding, plywood leaves, pressure treated lumber, pine needles, untreated lumber, wooden furniture, etc.)
16. House Trailers and campers, unless broken down for scrap metal pile
17. Any material that is not in a clear bag and does not have a bag tag sticker on the bag with the exception of items for the bulk pile or the electronic pile, at the discretion of the Operating Authority
18. Dump trucks not allowed over five (5) tonnes

Plastic bags of any kind are not accepted.

Waste in clear garbage bag	\$1.00/bag tag sticker effective April 01 2022 to December 31, 2022 \$1.50/bag tag sticker effective January 01, 2023 to December 31, 2024 \$2.00/bag tag sticker effective January 01, 2025
Metal Products	Free
Electronic waste: Radios, washer, dryer, water tank, metal bathtubs, televisions	Free
Sofa/couch, large chair, upholstered furniture	\$10.00 per item
Box spring, crib to cot size mattress and single mattress	\$5.00 per item
Double to king size mattress	\$10.00 per item
Table, chair (non-upholstered, interior/exterior, metal legs must be removed)	\$10.00 per five (5) pieces
Plastic: Chairs, tables, totes, kid seats, garbage containers	\$3.00 per item
Freon based units: Fridges, Freezers, A/C Units, Dehumidifiers, etc.	\$20.00 per item
NOTE: Some white goods/refrigeration equipment is subject to environmental regulations and restrictions. These will only be accepted at the Waste Site/Transfer Station if all laws and regulations permit! All white goods must have lids and doors removed! Barrels must have lids removed. Those that cannot be reused must be cut in half lengthwise. NO EXCEPTIONS.	
Tires (MUST be placed in area directed by the Operating Authority)	Free
Small household appliances: toasters, lawn chairs, food processors, kettles, etc. (MUST be placed in scrap metal pile)	Free

Receipts must be given for all fees paid.

Note: Any payments over \$50.00 must be made by cheque payable to The Township of Wollaston.
