CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON

BY-LAW NO 14-82

Whereas subsection 7 of section 104a of the Highway Traffic Act (RSO.1980, c.198) as amended provides that:


The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies.

And Whereas the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways in the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston and therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:


1. The provisions of subsections 1,2,4, and 4 of section 104a of the Highway Traffic Act apply to the highways named hereunder during the period from the 15th day of March of the 15th day of May inclusive in each and every year.
2. This by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.
