BY-LAW NO. ¹⁰~~9~~-84

RESTRICTION OF THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES PASSING
OVER A BRIDGE

WHEREAS subsection 2 of section 104(b) of the Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 198 as amended) provides that:

The Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a bridge may by by-law approved by the Ministry limit the gross weight of any vehicle or any class thereof passing over such bridge, and the requirements of subsection 12 with respect to the posting of notice apply thereto.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to limit the weight of vehicles passing over a bridge in the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:

1. No vehicle or combination of vehicles or any class thereof, whether empty or loaded, shall be operated over the bridge known as Deer River Bridge at Lot 54 on the West Hastings Road, site # 11266 in the Township of Wollaston where:
 - (a) in the case of a single vehicle the gross weight exceeds 2 tonnes,
 - (b) in the case of a combination of two vehicles the gross weight exceeds tonnes,
 - (c) in the case of a combination of three vehicles the gross weight exceeds tonnes.
2. ANY person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in section 106 of the Highway Traffic Act.
3. This By-Law shall not become effective until notice of the limit of weight permitted in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act has been posted in a conspicuous place at each end of the bridge, and until approved by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

N.B. Recent amendments to Ontario Regulations 668/78 providing for signing has prescribed the format of gross weight signs. These are contained in Reg. 396/79 and require signs erected on or after August 1, 1979 to comply with this regulation.

You will note that there are signs prescribed in Ontario Regulation 668/78 as amended by Ontario Regulation 396/79 prescribing the form of sign where you are restriction gross weight by vehicle or combination of vehicles. Such a sign must be in place where there is this type of restriction after January 1, 1981, and as stated in the above paragraph, must be in place for any restrictions and signs posted on or after 1, 1979.

Approved this 2nd day of November 1984 pursuant to subsection 104b(2) of the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1980 ch. 198 for a period of 2 years ending November 2nd, 1986.
