That no brush or trees, auto chassis parts, Septic wastes be deposited on ^{the} dump.

That a fine of \$500 be levied for dumping outside waste disposal site ^{hours (to 11)} ~~or around~~ gates that an ^{access} card be issued to Wollaston ratepayers at no charge, ~~and~~ also available to non-ratepayers at \$10.00 annually.

That non card holders be charged \$2.00 ^{per load} for household garbage.

Being a By-Law to close up and regulate the disposal of garbage and other refuse in the Township of Wollaston.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O, Chapter 284 as Amended, Section 354, Sub. Sec. 76 provides for Municipalities to pass by-laws for establishing and maintaining a system for the disposal of garbage and other refuse.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Township of Wollaston deems it expedient to provide for the disposal of garbage and other refuse within the Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

DEFINITIONS FOR THIS BY-LAW

- (a) Township; shall mean the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston.
- (b) Garbage; shall mean all rejected, abandoned or discarded household or commercial wastes but shall not include brush, trees, auto chassis parts or septic wastes.
- (c) Waste Disposal Site; shall mean that area within the Township of Wollaston being part of Lot 17, Concession 9, which is used solely for the purpose of disposing of garbage and refuse.
- (d) Waste Disposal Site Custodian; shall mean the person employed by the Township of Wollaston who is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Waste Disposal Site.

WASTE DISPOSAL SITE

- (1) The Waste Disposal site shall be accessible to all ratepayers and tenants with cards and those non residents who obtain a card at the Municipal Office by paying \$10.00 annually.
- (2) All garbage at the site shall be disposed under the direction of the Waste Disposal Site Custodian.
- (3) The Custodian for the site has the right to prohibit any person or persons from depositing any waste of whatever nature in the Waste Disposal Site if necessary.
- (4) Any person or persons found throwing garbage outside the defined area will be prosecuted under the terms of the By-Law.
- (5) Any person found creating malicious damage at the Waste Disposal Site shall be prosecuted under the terms of the By-Law.
- (6) The Township of Wollaston will accept no liability for damage to persons or vehicles while at the Waste Disposal Site.
- (7) A copy of the hours will be posted and sent out to all ratepayers along with a card for entrance to the site. An extra card will cost \$2.00.

(8) The Waste Disposal Custodian has full authority for the disposal of any materials suitable for recycling.


Enforcement:

1. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-Law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offence, exclusive of costs.
2. All former By-Laws and resolutions or parts thereof dealing with the provisions herein enacted are hereby repealed.
