LITTERING BY-LAW

BY-LAW NO: 21-90

**Being a By-Law to restrict
littering within the Municipality**

WHEREAS a municipally operated landfill site exists within the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality deems it desirable to encourage the usage of such landfill site and prohibit the littering along roads and property within the Municipality;


AND WHEREAS authority exist under Section 210 (76) of The Municipal Act to regulate this behaviour and under Section 321 of The Municipal Act to impose fines upon conviction contrary to that regulation.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AS A BY-LAW FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON
AS FOLLOWS:**


1. That the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the Municipality or any local Board thereof is prohibited without the authority from the owner or occupant of such property.
2. That any person who contravenes this By-Law is guilty of an offence punishable upon conviction by a fine of not more than \$2,000.00.

This By-Law read a first, second and third time and finally passed the 6 day of April, 1990.
