BY-LAW NO. 14-92

RESTRICTION OF THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES PASSING OVER A BRIDGE


WHEREAS subsection 104 b(2) of the Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O.) 1980, c. 198 as amended) provides that:


The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a bridge may by bylaw approved by the Ministry limit the gross weight of any vehicle or any class thereof passing over such bridge, and the requirements of subsection (1) with respect to the posting of notice apply thereto.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to limit the weight of vehicles passing over a bridge in the Corporation of Wollaston enacts as follows:

1. No vehicle or combination of vehicles of any class thereof, whether empty or loaded, shall be operated over the bridge known as Deer River Bridge at Lot 54 on West Hastings Road, Site # 11266 in the Township of Wollaston where:
 - (a) in the case of a single vehicle the gross weight exceeds TWO (2) Tonnes,
2. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in section 106 of the Highway Traffic Act.
3. This by-law shall not become effective until notice of the limit of weight permitted in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act has been posted in a conspicuous place at each end of the bridge, and until approved by the Ministry of Transportation, Ontario.






