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SCHEDULE "A"

This is Schedule "A" to By-Law No. 17-90

Respecting Classes of Permits and Permit Fees.

1. Building permits shall be applicable to construct, repair, renovations, extensions and or enlargement of buildings and structures including agricultural and farm buildings.

A fee of \$25.00 for the first \$1,000.00 value plus ~~\$3.00~~^{\$4.00} for each \$1,000.00 value or portion thereafter. Figures on a basis of \$55.00 a square foot for the main floor and \$30.00 a square foot for each additional floor.

2. Demolition permits flat fee of \$20.00.
3. Moving permit (relocation of building on property) flat rate of \$20.00.
4. Swimming pools a flat rate of \$40.00.
5. Chimneys a flat rate of \$25.00.
6. Garages, decks and accessory and unattached buildings charged at a value of \$12.00 a square foot.
7. Commercial and Industrial buildings charged at a rate of \$45.00 a square foot.




