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THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON

BY-LAW NO. 29-93

A BY-LAW TO RECIND BY-LAW # 14-92

WHEREAS BY-LAW # 14-92 of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston provides that, in accordance with Subsection 123 (2) of the Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8), the gross weight of any vehicle or any class thereof passing over the bridge on Deer River on Lot 54, Concession W.H.R. in the Township of Wollaston shall not exceed 2 tonnes.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston deem it in the interest of the Township to remove these restrictions.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:
