



# ROAD MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT MADE BETWEEN  
THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARMORA AND LAKE  
Hereinafter called "Marmora & Lake"

- and -

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON  
Hereinafter called "Wollaston"

## AGREEMENT FOR SUMMER AND WINTER MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN ROADS

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, RSO 1990, Chap.M.45, Sect. 271 allows adjoining municipalities to enter into an agreement for the maintenance and construction of boundary roads;

AND WHEREAS for the better maintenance and construction of certain roads, the municipalities have agreed to enter this Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual undertaking and agreements herein, and other good and valuable consideration, THE PARTIES AGREE as follows:

Each Corporation shall maintain and construct that portion allotted to them as set forth below.

The portion of the Marmora & Lake/Wollaston Boundary Road accepted by Marmora & Lake is that part from Murphy's Corners to Nicholson's Bridge, approximately 4.6km, presently surface treated; and from Coe Hill turn westerly to the end of the Boundary in Concession 4 of Lake Township, approximately 2.3km gravel. The total portion is approximately 6.9km.

The portion of the Marmora & Lake/Wollaston Boundary Road accepted by Wollaston is that part from Nicholson's Bridge westerly to Coe Hill turn, approximately 3.9 km presently surface treated; and from the Chandos Boundary, east to the end of the Boundary, approximately 2.2km gravel. The total portion is approximately 6.1km.

### SURVIVAL OF AGREEMENT

Should any clause herein be adjudged invalid by any Court entitled to do so, the balance of the provisions of this agreement shall survive, for the ten year period allowed under the Municipal Act. Either Municipality shall have the right to notify the other in writing with ninety (90) days notice, that they wish to opt out of the existing agreement and renegotiate a new agreement.




