THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON

POLICY FOR SNOWPLOWING AND SANDING

BY-LAW NO. 12-95

Plowing will commence when 7.0 cm of snow has accumulated. Plowing will be continuous from the beginning of the storm to the end of the storm except during sleet or freezing rain.

All main roads will be plowed first, followed by major side roads and concessions.

In the event of freezing rain, sanding does not commence until the rain subsides.

The Municipality is requesting the Public's co-operation not to park their vehicles along roadways or in snowplow turn-a-rounds as it interferes with snow removal. Failure to comply with this request may result in the vehicle being towed away at the owners expense.
