

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON

BY-LAW NO. 1-98

A by-law to accept private lands conveyed to the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston described as Part of Lot 19, Concession 2, being designated as Part 1, Plan 21R-18216 and reconvey same to the Ridge Congregation of the United Church of Canada.

WHEREAS Gary Paul Pattison presented a proposal to the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston the lands described above would be transferred as a donation to the Ridge United Church for the enlargement of the present cemetery.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston approved the proposal and its conditions by Resolution No. 2-97 on July 22, 1997.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston feels it is in the municipal purpose to assist in the enlargement of the cemetery at the Ridge United Church at no expense to the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Council hereby accepts the lands described as Part Lot 19, Concession 2, being Part 1, Plan 21R-18216.
2. That Council hereby authorize the transfer of the said property to the Ridge Congregation of the United Church of Canada and the Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute same.
3. That all legal, survey and other associated fees in connection with the transfer of the lands to the municipality and the subsequent transfer from the municipality to the Ridge United Church be assumed by the parties involved in the transfer of the land other than the Municipality of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 7th day of January, 1998.
