

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON  
BY-LAW NO.

---

Being a By-Law to apportion the cost of fencing the lands of the abandoned Railway which are owned by The Corporation of the Township of Wollaston

WHEREAS Section 210, Subsection 27 of the Municipal Act provides that a By-Law may be passed for determining how the cost of division fences shall be apportioned in defined areas of this Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This By-Law is restricted in its application to those parts of the Right-of-Way of the abandoned Canadian National Railway conveyed to this municipal corporation.
2. The cost of any division fence between the lands described in Paragraph 1 above and any adjoining lands is apportioned entirely to the owner or owners of those adjoining lands.
3. The Line Fences Act, R.S.O., Chapter 17 shall no longer apply to those lands described in Paragraph 1 hereof.
