



Being a by-law to establish rules and costs associated with the erection and maintenance of Business signs within the Township of Wollaston.

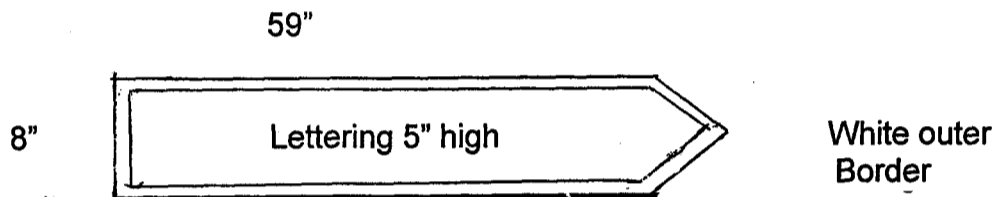
Specifications

Signs to be made of 3/4 " plywood
8" x 59"

Ministry Interstate 175 Blue (Confirmed by the Ministry of Transportation)
Font: Gothic (D font or C Compressed)) (Confirmed by the Ministry of Transportation)

5" letters (Confirmed by Jude at Jude's signs)

This size of lettering will allow for enough space around the lettering on the sign and allow for the white outer border as well.



Businesses will order their own signs and pay for them themselves.
Wollaston Township will erect the signs on Township posts under the supervision of the Road Superintendent.

Costs

For a new business – 1st year \$100.00 per location.

Back to back, same wording signs, for the same business
on one pole \$100.00

Maintenance fee for pole per year \$20.00.

For existing Businesses - \$20.00 per year.

Upkeep of the signs is the Business owner's responsibility.
Maintenance and repair of the post is the Township's responsibility.

Note: These costs will be reviewed and if necessary may be revised.

This does not affect Yard Sale, Election signs or Real Estate signs.
