By-Law No. 51-02

BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH POLICY ON GIVING NOTICE TO AND CONSULTING WITH THE PUBLIC.

WHEREAS Section 2 of the Municipal Act 2001 provides municipalities powers and duties under this Act and many other Acts;


AND WHEREAS Section 251 of the Municipal Act 2001 delegates this matter to each municipality:


Where a municipality is required to give notice under provision of this Act, the municipality shall, except as otherwise provided, give notice in a form and in the manner and at times that the Council considers adequate to give reasonable notice under the provision.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:

- 1) THAT notice will be given in written form
- 2) THAT adequate notices for special meetings as called by the Reeve or Council, as per the Act, will be posted in the Township Municipal Office Building at 90 Wollaston Lake Road, unless in the case of an emergency as deemed by a quorum of Council then adequate notice may not be given as per above;
- 3) THAT adequate notice for such items as public meetings and job postings, but not limited to will be posted at the Township Municipal Office Building at 90 Wollaston Lake Road and at the Coe Hill Post Office 2269 Hwy 620 with owners permission;
- 4) THAT if Council chooses to give notice in a local paper, commercial gazette or any other forum of public viewing it shall first be authorized by resolution of Council; and
- 5) THAT this by-law repeals all previous by-law's and /or Motions of Council pertaining to same and shall come into effect upon the passing thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 5th day of November, 2002.
