WHEREAS The Municipal Act, 2001, Section 34, provides that before passing a By-Law for permanent closing of a highway the Municipality shall give public notice of its intention to pass the By-Law;

AND WHEREAS Section 251 thereof provides that the Municipality shall give notice in a form and in the manner and at the times that the Council considers adequate to give reasonable notice under such provision;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:

1. The Council of The Corporation of the Township of Wollaston considers that adequate notice of the passing of a By-Law to close and sell part or all of a highway under the provisions of Section 34 of The Municipal Act, 2001, shall consist of publication of such notice in "The Bancroft Times", a weekly newspaper published in the Town of Bancroft, Ontario, or any other weekly newspaper having wide circulation in the Township of Wollaston, once per week for four (4) consecutive weeks together with posting of such notice for at least 31 days in six of the most public places in the immediate neighbourhood of the portion of highway being closed and giving notice that this Council shall consider passing of such By-Law, at a place and time to be stated in such notice.
