THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON
BY-LAW NO. 06-03.

Being a By-Law to stop up and close and to sell part of the Road Allowance along Wollaston (Eagle) Lake in front of Lot 13, Concession 6, in the Township of Wollaston in the County of Hastings, being more particularly described as PART 1, PLAN 21R-20524.

WHEREAS the owner of the lands adjacent to the Road Allowance above described has requested the Council of this municipality to close and to convey the same to him in accordance with the provisions of The Municipal Act, 2001.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston has considered that the portion of the Road Allowance above described is not required for municipal purposes.


AND WHEREAS it would appear that no person would be deprived of the means of ingress or egress to or from his lands or place of residence by reason of the passing of this By-law, whether by motor vehicle or otherwise.

AND WHEREAS Notice of this By-Law has been published and posted up and any person has been given the opportunity to be heard in accordance with the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45, S.300 and in accordance with The Municipal Act, 2001 and the procedures for giving notice adopted by this Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Part of the Road Allowance along Wollaston (Eagle) Lake in front of Lot 13, Concession 6, Township of Wollaston, County of Hastings, more particularly described as PART 1, PLAN 21R-20524 is hereby stopped up and closed.
2. That the Reeve and Clerk of this Municipality are hereby authorized for the purpose of this By-Law to cause all things to be done in accordance with the relevant legislation necessary to render this By-Law effective.
3. That the Reeve and Clerk of this Municipality are authorized on behalf of this municipality and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act to sell and convey the aforesaid portion of the original road allowance to the abutting owners at a price fixed at \$4,600.00.
