

The new Municipal Act states that a public meeting should be held if changes to budget occurs. Council has declined meeting because it feels the increase in transfer from reserve, to finance increase cost of road reconstruction does not constitute budget change. This allotment was received from the Province of Ontario when 620 Highway was transferred. It was dedicated at that time by the Province for this type of capital work which is being done. The money being used is the end of the allotment. This is on advise from the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and the Township Legal Counsel.
