**By-Law 21-07**

**Repeal by-law 13-01**

Being a by-law to establish a reduced load period on Township Roads.

Whereas Subsection 7 of Section 104a of the Highway Traffic Act R.S.O. 1980 Chapter 198 as amended provides that:

The Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies:


And Whereas the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of all highways in the Township of Wollaston which are under the jurisdiction of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston.


Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of subsections 1,2,3 and 4 of section 104a of the Highway Traffic Act apply to all highways under the jurisdiction of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston , during the period from March 1<sup>st</sup> until June 1<sup>st</sup> inclusive in each and every year, and upon the discretion of the Road Superintendent.
2. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 106 of the Highway Traffic Act and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offenses Act.
3. This by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected in accordance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2007.
