
By-Law 61-07

THIS AGREEMENT made in duplicate the 21st day of August 2007

BETWEEN

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF BANCROFT

Hereinafter called the "TOWN"

OF THE FIRST PART

and

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WOLLASTON

Hereinafter called the "MUNICIPALITY"

OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS the Town entered into an agreement on July 22, 1996, with the County of Hastings to acquire the North Hastings Rescue Support Vehicle and associated extrication equipment as it was the intention of the County of Hastings to end its participation in the program;

AND WHEREAS the Town did agree to assume full responsibility for the Auto Extrication Program as established by the Province of Ontario and to provide equipment and services required under the said program to all municipalities in the County of Hastings serviced by the Ontario Provincial Police, Bancroft Detachment;

AND WHEREAS the Town is desirous to enter into agreements with other municipalities for the sharing of funding of operating expenses and future capital costs;

NOW THEREFORE the agreement witnesseth that the parties hereto, for themselves and their respective successors, mutually covenant and agree as follows:

TOWN

1. The Town agrees to assume ownership of the North Hastings Rescue Support Vehicle and all related equipment.

2. The Town agrees to assume full responsibility for the Auto Extrication Program as established by the Province of Ontario and to provide equipment and services required under the said program to all municipalities in the County of Hastings serviced by the Ontario Provincial Police, Bancroft Detachment.
3. The Town will provide adequate manpower for the rescue unit to respond to a request as follows:
 - (a) from any Fire Department, Police Department or Ambulance Service in the area designated in Paragraph 2 above;
 - (b) from an adjoining Rescue Support Vehicle for assistance.
4. The Town agrees to provide representation on a Rescue Unit Committee which will manage the financial affairs of the Auto Extrication Program.

TOWNSHIP / MUNICIPALITY

1. The Municipality agrees to provide fire protection and assistance at incidents where the rescue support vehicle is requested, if such fire protection services are available within the Municipality (i.e. fire protection services are not available in the Township of Carlow/Mayo).

GENERAL

1. The parties hereto agree that the Municipality is entitled to representation on the North Hastings Rescue Unit Committee.
2. The parties hereto agree that the Rescue Unit Committee has the ultimate authority to provide for an appropriate cost recovery invoicing procedure.
3. The parties hereto agree that any previous Rescue Support Vehicle Agreement with the Municipality and all provisions contained therein shall terminate upon execution of this agreement.
4. Nothing in this agreement shall prevent the Town from entering into an agreement with other municipalities for the sharing of funding of operating expenses and/or future capital costs for the Rescue Support Vehicle.

ANNUAL RETAINER FEE

1. The parties hereto agree to pay the North Hastings Rescue Unit Committee an annual retainer fee in accordance with Schedule "A", attached hereto, to assist with the funding of operating costs and future capital costs associated with the rescue support vehicle. Schedule "A" may be amended, from time to time, by way of a resolution of the respective Council.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties hereto have executed this agreement on the date first above written, and the parties have affixed their Corporate Seal duly attested to by their respective proper signing authority.




