
THEREFORE be it resolved that the Township of Wollaston authorizes that this money will be used for municipal road and bridge capital investment needs:


AND FURTHERMORE that a final summary report detailing expenditures, use of municipal funding and outcomes achieved shall be submitted to the ministry and the ministry may request an independent audit of the project:

AND any funds intended for the project that are not used in accordance with rehabilitation of municipal road and capital investment needs of the terms outlined above will be returned to the ministry. An investment statement will be provided to the ministry outlining the capital investment and road project (including detailed costs) associated directly to this investment which may be postponed to the 2009 fiscal year.
