The Corporation of the Township of Wollaston

By-Law 36-09

Being a by-law to decrease the speed of motor vehicles from statutory speed limits.

WHEREAS subsection 2 of section 128 of The Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O. 1990. Chapter 11-8) authorizes the Council of a Municipality and the Trustees of a Police Village by By-Law to prescribe a speed limit of 40,50,60,70, 80,90 or 100 kilometers per hour for motor vehicles driven on any highway or portion of highway under its jurisdiction.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed of motor vehicles on certain highways in the Township of Wollaston be restricted;

AND THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:


1. When any highway or portion of highway set out below is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be 50 kilometers per hour.



2. The penalties provided in subsection 14 section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this By-Law.
3. That all former By-Laws contrary to this By-Law shall be repealed.
