
**By-Law 79-09**



**Schedule A**

**Procedure for Livestock Evaluation**

Report from resident regarding livestock kill will come into the Township of Wollaston office.

The office staff will report the incident to Frank Mills the Livestock evaluator and he will set up an appointment to visit the resident or will call them to investigate the problem.

Frank Mills will prepare an affidavit with the resident.

Wollaston Township will prepare a \$50.00 cheque for Frank Mills that will cover all of the required paperwork for this paperwork and time involved.

Frank will then prepare a report of the livestock evaluator which will give the value of the livestock that has been killed. This will determine the cheque amount that will need to be prepared by Wollaston Township to be sent to the resident.

Frank will then prepare an application for grant dollars to come back to the Township of Wollaston to offset the amount paid to the resident. This application includes photos if any , the affidavit, the report of the livestock evaluator. This grant application is sent to the Robin Chandra, Client Service Audit Report, Property Tax & Farm Finance, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor S E , 1 Stone Road W., Guelph, ON N1G 4Y2. It takes approximately 4-6 weeks for the cheque to come back to the Municipality.
