By-Law 08-10

Being a by-law repealing By-Law 52-09 and appointing an On Site Sewage Inspector who has the same powers and duties as the Chief Building Official in relation to sewage systems, for the Township of Wollaston.

WHEREAS The Council of the Township of Wollaston has the authority under the Ontario Building Code Part 8, 8.9.2.2. (1) Every sewage system shall be operated in accordance with (a) the basis on which the construction and use of the sewage system was approved or required under this Act or predecessor legislation, as the case may be, and (b) the requirements of the manufacturer of the sewage system” and amendments thereto,

And under the Building Code Act Section 15.9 (1) an inspector may enter upon land and into buildings at any reasonable time without a warrant for the purpose of inspecting a building to determine, (a) whether the building is unsafe
And under the Building Code Act Section 15.9 (3) a sewage system is unsafe if it is not maintained or operated in accordance with the Act and the Building Code


to appoint a person to inspect and issue permits for sewage systems within their municipal jurisdiction:

AND WHEREAS THE Council of the Township of Wollaston is desirous of appointing such a person to conduct inspections and issue permits for sewage systems, pursuant to the Ontario Building Code , the Building Code Act 2006 and amendments thereto:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Dylinna Brock is hereby appointed as the On Site Sewage System Inspector who has the same powers and duties as Chief Building Official in relation to sewage systems, for the Township of Wollaston effective February 17th, 2010.
