Being a By-Law authorizing the donation of two parcels of township lands to Wollaston Heritage Inc.


**WHEREAS** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston wishes to support Wollaston Heritage Inc. by donating land to their Coe Hill heritage restoration project

**NOW THEREFORE** The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston does enact as follows:

1. **THAT** the Clerk is hereby authorized to proceed with the transfer of two parcels of land, being 0 High St. Plan 549 Lot 21 and 0 High St. Plan 549 Lot 27 from Wollaston Township to Wollaston Heritage Inc.
2. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010 and that all former By-Laws governing such matters are hereby repealed.
