**By-Law 38-10**


Being a By-Law determining and declaring specified municipally owned lands described below to be surplus.

**WHEREAS** 0 High St. Plan 549 Lot 21 and 0 High St. Plan 549 Lot 27 are not required by the Township for municipal purposes and are therefore surplus to the needs of the Township pursuant to Section 2 of By-Law 95-15;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston does enact as follows:

1. **THAT** the Township of Wollaston intends to donate the above described lands to Wollaston Heritage Inc.
2. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the 12th day of October, 2010 and that all former By-Laws governing such matters are hereby repealed.
