By-Law 52-10

Being a By-Law to appoint a Community Emergency Management Coordinator for the Township of Wollaston, pursuant to the Standards established by Regulation under the Emergency Management & Civil Protection Act, R.S.O., 1990, Ch. E 9, as amended.

WHEREAS the Emergency Management & Civic Protection Act, Section 2.1 (1) requires every municipality to develop and implement an emergency management program;

AND WHEREAS Section 14 (1) of the Emergency Management & Civil Protection Act requires emergency management programs conform with regulatory standards, in accordance with international best practices;


AND WHEREAS the regulatory standard established under Ontario Regulation 380/04 requires that each municipality designate a Community Emergency Management Coordinator;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston does enact as follows:

1. **THAT** CAO/Clerk Christine FitzSimons is hereby designated Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC) for the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston and that Waste Site Manager Dylinna Brock is hereby designated Alternate CEMC.
2. **THAT** the Community Emergency Management Coordinator shall be responsible for the development, implementation and maintenance of the Wollaston Township Emergency Management Program in accordance with the Emergency Management & Civil Protection Act, R.S.O., 1990, Ch.E9, as amended, and the regulations passed there under.
2. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of December, 2010 and that all former By-Laws governing such matters are hereby repealed.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed this 1st day of December, 2010.
