By -Law No. 18-11

A By-Law to enact the amendment of By-Law 50-10, being a By-Law to regulate the use of land, height, bulk, location, spacing, character and the use of buildings.

WHEREAS BY-law 50-10, being the Comprehensive Zoning By-Law of the Township of Wollaston, zones Concession 6, Part Lot 23, 21R-20514 Part 1

AND WHEREAS an application for the rezoning of Concession 6, Part Lot 23, 21R-20514 Part 1 from Rural to Rural Residential


AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston deems it advisable to amend the Township's Comprehensive Zoning By-Law No 50-10;


NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:

1. That Concession 6, Part Lot 23, 21R-20514 Part 1 in the Township of Wollaston as shown on the attached Schedule A sketch, being one and the same are hereby changed from Rural (RU), to Rural Residential (RR).

1. The use of the subject lands shall be in conformity with the standards of the RR zone.
2. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the twentieth day after the day that the giving of written notice was given, providing no notice of appeal is filed. In the event that an appeal is filed, this By-Law shall not come into force and take effect until finally disposed of by the Ontario Municipal Board.

Read a First, Second and Third time and finally passed this 12th day of April, 2011.
