THAT the Façade Improvement Grant Program applies to the Community Improvement Plan Project Area within the Policy Area, defined as:


#1984 to #2358 on the North Side of Hwy 620 in the Hamlet of Coe Hill


#2019 to #2387A on the South Side of Hwy 620 in the Hamlet of Coe Hill;
