

**The Corporation of the Township of Wollaston**  
**By – Law 05-16**

**Being a By-Law to establish remuneration for the  
Council and paying of expenses incurred by  
members of the Council.**

**WHEREAS** Section 283 (2) of The Municipal Act., 2001, as amended, provides that despite any Act, a municipality may only pay the expenses of the members of its Council or of any local board of the municipality and of the officers and employees of the municipality or local board if the expenses are of those persons in their capacity as members, officers or employees and if,

- (a) the expenses are actually incurred; or
- (b) the expenses are, in lieu of the expenses actually incurred, a reasonable estimate, in the opinion of the Council or local board, of the actual expenses that would be incurred.

**AND WHEREAS** Section 283 (4) of The Municipal Act., 2001, as amended, provides that no part of the remuneration of a member of a Council or local board paid under this section is deemed to be for expenses incidental to his or her duties as a member and a municipality or local board shall not provide that any part of the remuneration is for such deemed expenses.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:

1. That the remuneration of the members of Council for the 2016 calander year shall be paid as follows and one-third of such amount shall be deemed to be for expenses incidental to the discharge of such duties as a member:

Reeve	\$8,250.00
Deputy Reeve	\$7,450.00
Councillor	\$7,450.00


2. That remuneration shall be paid on a monthly basis. This salary shall allow for up to 3 absences from Council meetings per calendar year without penalty. Additional absences shall require a resolution of Council, or wages shall be deducted at a rate of:

Reeve	\$267.75
Deputy Reeve	\$242.25
Councillor	\$242.25 per meeting absence.

3. That members of Council shall be paid mileage per kilometer for the use of private vehicles while on authorized Municipal business.
4. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect as of January 1, 2016 and that all former by-laws governing such allowances are hereby repealed.
