

The Corporation of the Township of Wollaston
By – Law 20 -19

**Being a By-Law to establish remuneration for the
Council and paying of expenses incurred by
members of the Council.**

WHEREAS Section 283 (2) of The Municipal Act., 2001, as amended, provides that despite any Act, a municipality may only pay the expenses of the members of its Council or of any local board of the municipality and of the officers and employees of the municipality or local board if the expenses are of those persons in their capacity as members, officers or employees and if,

- (a) the expenses are actually incurred; or
- (b) the expenses are, in lieu of the expenses actually incurred, a reasonable estimate, in the opinion of the Council or local board, of the actual expenses that would be incurred.

AND WHEREAS Section 283 (4) of The Municipal Act., 2001, as amended, provides that no part of the remuneration of a member of a Council or local board paid under this section is deemed to be for expenses incidental to his or her duties as a member and a municipality or local board shall not provide that any part of the remuneration is for such deemed expenses.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston enacts as follows:

1. That the remuneration of the members of Council for the 2019 calendar year shall be paid as follows:

Reeve	\$8,256.00
Deputy Reeve	\$7,392.00
Councillor	\$7,392.00

2. This salary shall allow for up to 3 absences from Council meetings per calendar year without penalty. Additional absences shall require a resolution of Council, or wages shall be deducted at a rate of:

Reeve	\$294.85
Deputy Reeve	\$264.00
Councillor	\$264.00 per meeting absence.

3. This salary is intended to compensate Council for up to 28 meetings per calendar year. If attendance of all of Council is required at more than 30 meetings within the year, members shall be compensated for their attendance at a rate of:

Reeve	\$294.85
Deputy Reeve	\$264.00
Councillor	\$264.00 per meeting.

4. That members of Council shall be paid 52 cents per kilometer for the use of private vehicles while on authorized Municipal business.

5. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect as of January 1, 2019 and that By-Law 50-17 governing such allowances is hereby repealed.
