

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOLLASTON

By-law No. 38 - 2021

Being a By-law to appoint a By-law Enforcement Officer and Chief Building Official for the Township of Wollaston

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Section 5 (3) states that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under Section 8, shall be exercised by the By-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise.

AND WHEREAS The Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.p. 15, Part 1, Section 15, empowers a Municipal Council to appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS The Building Code Act, S.O. 1992, Chapter 23, Section 3 (2), states the Council of each municipality shall appoint a Chief Building Official and such Inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of this Act, in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT CHRISTOPHER MATHER, be and the same, is hereby appointed as Chief Building Official and By-law Enforcement Officer for the Township of Wollaston, effective May 31, 2021.
2. THAT the By-law Enforcement Officer and Chief Building Official shall be responsible for ensuring that the By-laws of the Municipality are enforced and for carrying into effect the provisions of The Building Code Act and any Regulations thereunder;
3. THAT CHRISTOPHER MATHER shall be paid such remuneration as set out in the Shared Service Agreement between the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston and the Corporation of the Township of Carlow/Mayo.
4. THAT all provisions of this By-law shall take effect as of May 31, 2021.
5. THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
6. THAT this By-law repeals all previous By-laws and/or Motions of Council pertaining to the same.
