

LOTTERY LICENCE

The Township of Wollaston has the authority to issue lottery licences to eligible organizations within the community (charitable and religious organizations only). We are also responsible for enforcing licencing policies and compliance under the terms and conditions of the licences we issue.

Our Municipal Clerk's Department issues lottery licences in accordance with Provincial Regulations.

When Do I need a Licence?

Eligible groups are able to submit an application for a lottery licence. 3rd party groups wishing to help a charitable group are encouraged to speak directly with the organization, as licences are only able to be issued to the licensed group.
